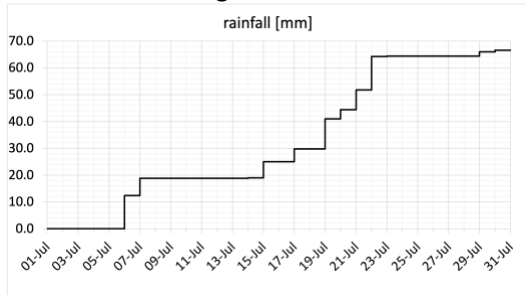
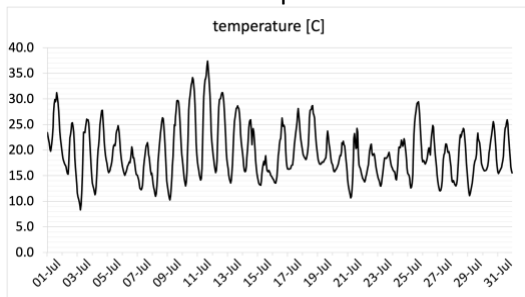


## OffWeather – July 2025

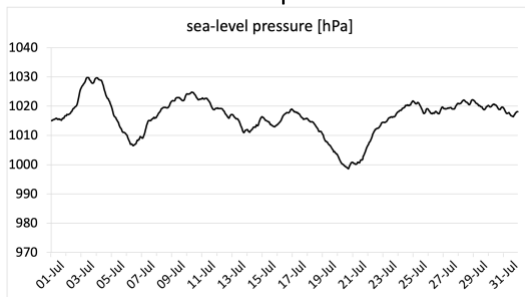
With 66.6mm of rain this month was 17% above the average for July. There were 19 days with no measurable rainfall. This year's rainfall remains well below average. The total evapotranspiration was 101mm. The ground lost 35mm of moisture due to periods of high temperatures.



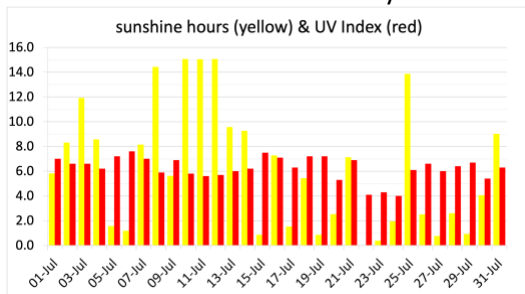
The average temperature was 20.0°C, which is 2.1°C above the area's average and also 2.1°C above that of last July. The highest temperature this July of 37.8°C was on the 11<sup>th</sup>. Note that my weather station does not measure temperatures to the Met Office standard, but are accurate measurements at the specific location in Offchurch.

The pressure averaged 1016hPa. The maximum pressure was 1029hPa with a minimum of 1000hPa. Pressure was relatively stable this month with no extremes.



There were 191 hrs of sunshine, which is only 92% of the average but 25 more hours than last year. There was just 1 day when no sunshine was recorded. Winds were light to moderate, variable but mostly northerly with a max gust of 23 mph on two days.
